Location:

Sikorsky Aircraft, Stratford, CT

Eligibility:

Each troop may register a **patrol**, which is expected to be eight Scouts and two adults. Scouts must be at least 14 years old and at least First Class. At least one leader must attend from every unit. If female Venturers are attending, a female leader must attend. **A talent release form is required from every Scout. This is located in Part A of the BSA Annual Health Form.** Every effort will be made to accommodate those with disabilities and/or medical conditions.

Cost:

\$40.00 (for Scouts and adults), if paid by August 15, includes Merit Badge instruction, meals (Friday snack, all meals on Saturday, and Sunday breakfast), and Camp Sikorsky patch. The fee is \$50.00 after August 15 and for out-of-Council participants. After August 15, interested units may inquire about registering additional Scouts on a first come, first served basis.

Registration Process:

Completed Registration Form and fees must be submitted by 5:00 p.m. on August 15, 2014, to the Scout Resource Center. Fees must be submitted with your registration form. Registrations will not be processed without proper forms and payment. Space is limited. Those registered without a rank or citizenship will not be considered.

Memorabilia:

T-shirts and hats will be offered for sale. Please **PRE-ORDER** on the registration form (very limited supply will be available that weekend).

Uniforms:

Participants must be in complete uniform for the entire weekend or will be sent home.
