CAMP STRANG BUY-A-BRICK PROGRAM INFORMATION SHEET

- * The Buy-a-Brick program is intended to raise funds for the Capital improvement and the maintenance of Camp Strang. 50% of the profits will go directly to the Capital improvement fund and 50% to Endowment Fund. The Endowment helps to fund future camp improvements.
- * We are encouraging Unit and individual participation. We will soon be also looking to corporate participation. Please reach out to Scouting parents, family, friends and local businesses to purchase a brick. It is tax deductible contribution.
- * Each unit should appoint a UNIT Coordinator to drive the unit and individual participation.

* <u>Unit Program participation</u>:

- The unit buys the Central Paver(s). Scouting families then purchase the bricks it will be surrounded by.
- Pick the Central Paver(s) and have the Unit Coordinator complete the order form.
- Scouts and Scouters then decide how they want their names displayed on the bricks. The Unit Coordinator then completes the Red Brick order form.
- The cost for the red bricks with two names is \$28.00 per name. For one name on one brick, the cost is \$32. Price of bricks includes spacer bricks.
- ONLY the red bricks purchased through the unit program will be placed around and with the unit paver in the walkway.
- Bricks purchased through the individual program will be placed randomly around the walkway.
- The first 4 Units to submit completed forms and payment will get the first four unit spaces closest to the American flag pole.
- There will be a square area surrounding the American Flag pole for \$1,000.00 + donor bricks.
- * This is an ongoing program that will continue.
- * All orders that are received by March 1, 2008 will be processed for installation for the opening of Summer Camp.
