Babies and Small Children at Camp Policy

Purpose

The purpose of this policy is to ensure the safety of our Scout's family members while they are visiting our camping grounds.

Policy

The policy states that visitors who visit camp for the day can bring small children. However, if a visitor is staying overnight, that person becomes a leader. The only children that will be allowed to stay will be a child of registered scout age. Babies and small children are to be kept away from the activity station areas.

When a visitor stays overnight, he/she becomes a leader and that person needs to be registered at camp and have a physical form (Class 1). The child of scout age also needs to be registered and have a physical form (Class 1).
