## Camp Visitor Code of Conduct 2006

**Statement of Understanding**: You are our welcome guests and we are glad to share our camp facilities with you. Please understand that Camp Strang is first and foremost a Scouting facility and all visitors are expected to abide by the Code of Conduct below. Ultimately, you are responsible for your own behavior, your children's behavior and the behavior of all children whom you have custody. **Serious misconduct or infraction of these rules and regulations may result in expulsion, at your own expense, from the camp. All decisions will be final.** 

## **Code of Conduct**

To help us and friends and relatives know your whereabouts, sign the guest roster located at the camp office.

Respect Scout and camp property. You are personally responsible for any loss, breakage, or vandalism of property as a result of your actions. Do not cut or mark any trees or deface any rocks or buildings.

Turn off light and water when not needed.

Help us keep the camp clean by not littering.

You are responsible for keeping your quarters and personal possessions clean and neat.

Food is permitted in designated dining areas only.

Garbage and trash must be disposed of in the dumpster(s) located near the front gate.

Be considerate of others by keeping yourself appropriately attired.

Footgear must be worn at all times.





Theft, the purchase, possession, or consumption of alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs is prohibited and will be grounds for immediate expulsion from the camp property.

Toxic chemicals may not be brought or stored on camp property.

Smoking is permitted only in designated areas away from all participants. Smoking is <u>not</u> permitted in tents, camp building, or structures.

Gambling of any form is prohibited. No pornographic materials are allowed.

Fireworks, firearms, lasers and weapons are prohibited.

No pets are allowed in camp.

Don't tease or chase wildlife or livestock. Watch but don't touch.

Prior to exiting the camp premises, stop at the camp office and advise the person in attendance that you and your group are leaving. Any and all incidents, injury or damage will be reported to the Camp Director prior to your departing the camp premises.
